- To raise items of news and opportunities relevant to the Institute from their network and experience as an early-career horticulturist.

Promotion of the Institute

- To advocate the wider role and function of the Institute when attending any events and functions.
- If tasked by Council, to represent and promote the Institute at external events and meetings.

Supporting CIH Initiatives for early-career horticulturists

- Liaise with other CIH student representatives and members.
- Contribute to newsletters and other communications activities that promote the student experience and career development in horticulture.
